God made a rainbow and promised Noah that He would never destroy the earth with a flood again. The rainbow would always remind God of this.

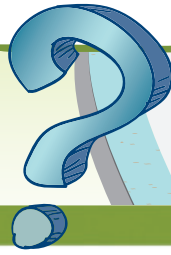

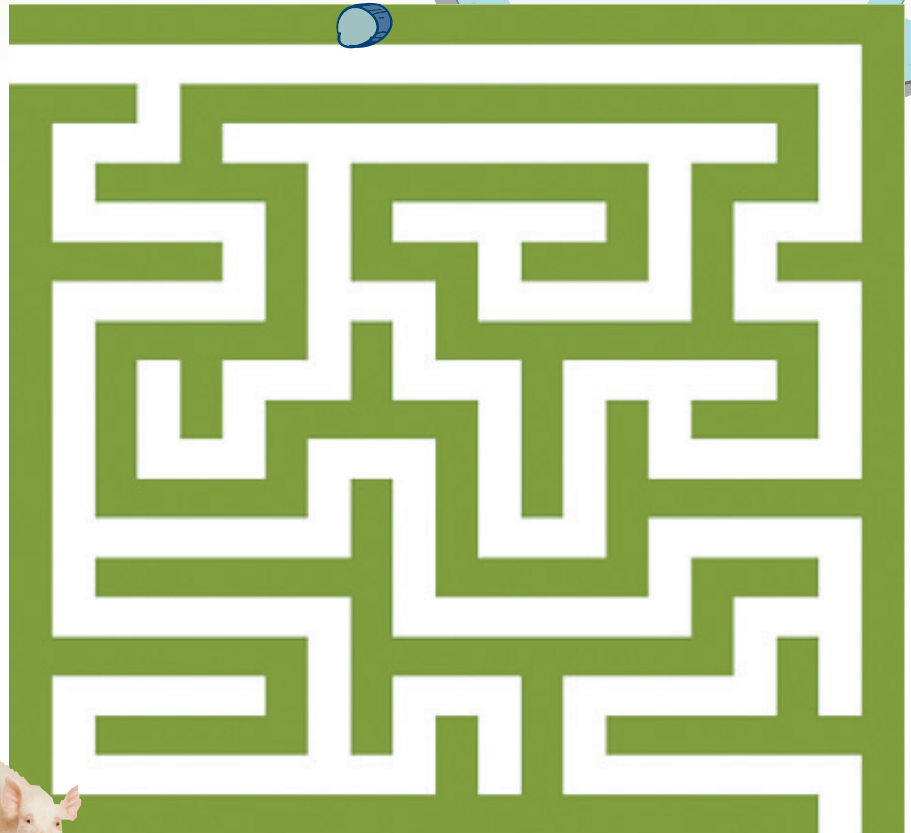

Lesson Objective: To have children become familiar with the story of Noah's Ark.

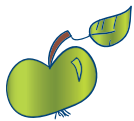
Bible Reading:
